








ハートマークです。「また会いたいね(ハート)」の ように使います。とてもよく使われます。



わかれのマークです。「彼氏と別れちゃったー(別 れハート)」のように使います。




なみだをながしている顔です。「ショックだったあ o(T_T)o」のように使います。



Let's send e-mails by cell phone. Write fun e-mails using picture symbols and face symbols.




Japanese cell phones have a lot of pictograms and face symbols. With these symbols, you can express various feelings.




These are smiling faces. They are used when you want to say "Good morning (face)" or something like that.



This is a heart mark. You can use it for "I want to see you again (heart)" or something similar. This symbol is used very often.



This is a symbol of parting. It is used when writing something like "I have broken up with my boyfriend (broken heart)."




These are sad faces in tears, and can be used as "I'm shocked o(T_T)o."
